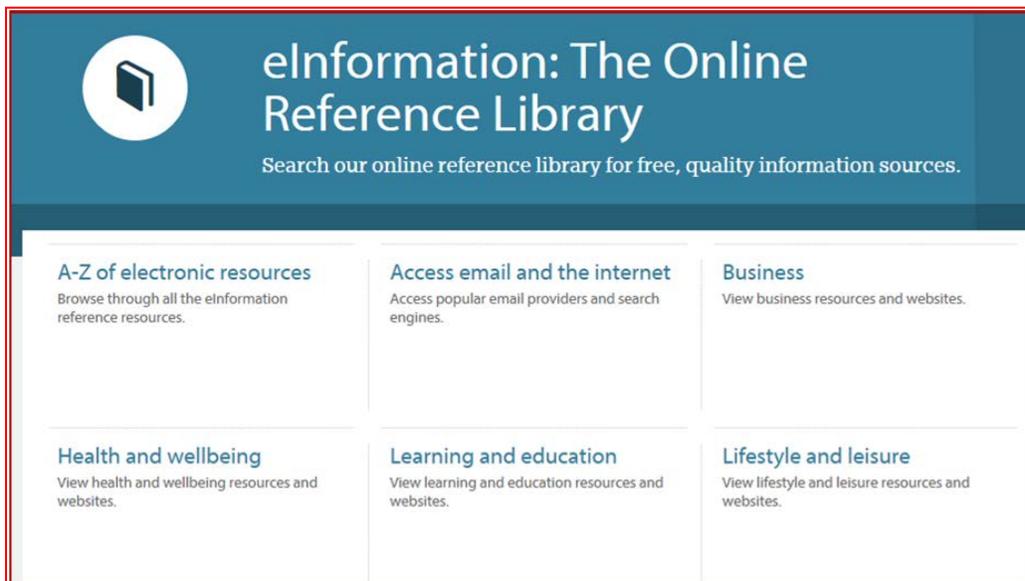


Help with the John Johnson Collection

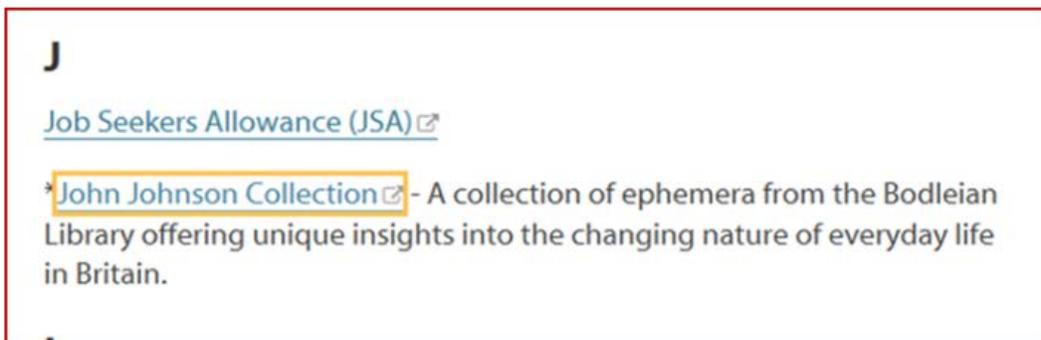

Go to [eInformation: Online Reference Library](#) and click **A-Z of electronic resources**.

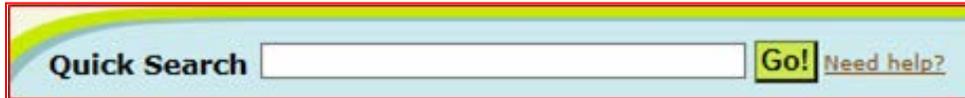


Then scroll down to the **John Johnson collection**. If using your own device, you will need to login with your library card number.



How to search

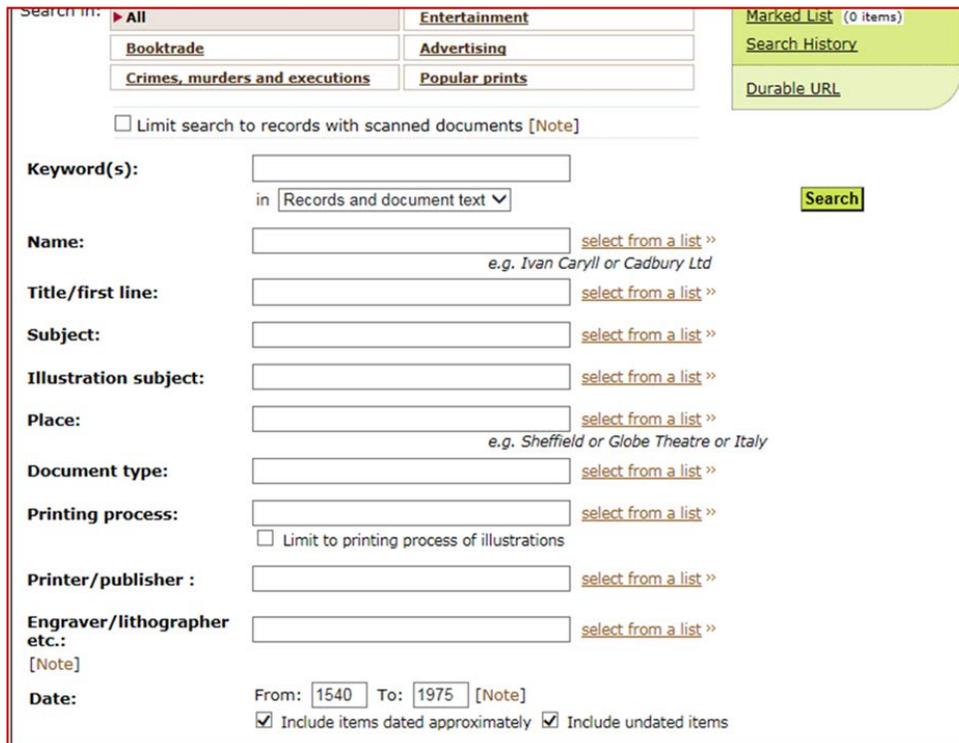
Enter your search term in the box at the top right of the home page and click **Go**. Click the **Need Help** link (circled, below) to get suggestions to help improve your searching.
