


7. **My Britannica** is another useful feature. It allows you to save articles or citations to work on later. This is particularly useful if you are doing research, working on an essay or just revising. The link to set up your login is on the right-hand side of the screen.



Once the best known reference book in the world, Encyclopædia Britannica is now the most prestigious online encyclopædia. It is the first place to look for information on absolutely anything.

1. Type www.westsussex.gov.uk/einformation into your browser and click on **A-Z of electronic resources**. Then scroll down to **Britannica Library**.



2. Note that there are three levels of complexity: **Adult**, **Student** and **Junior**. Select the appropriate level for your search.
