The John Johnson Collection of Printed Ephemera offers unique insights into the changing nature of everyday life in Britain in the eighteenth, nineteenth and early twentieth centuries. You can access it in any West Sussex library and 24/7 from your computer, tablet or smartphone once you are a member.

1. Go to [www.westsussex.gov.uk/einformation](http://www.westsussex.gov.uk/einformation) and click on **A-Z of electronic resources**. Then scroll down to the **John Johnson collection**. If using your own device you will need to login with your library card number.
