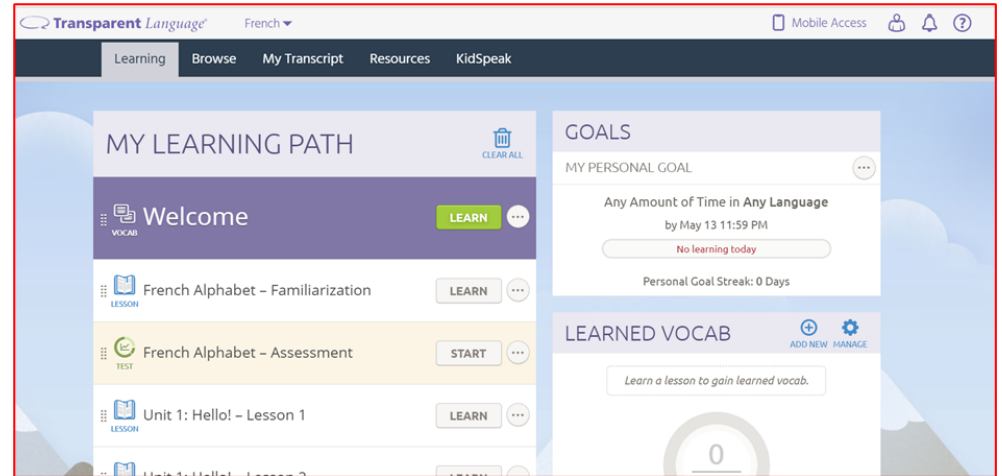
3. To start learning you will need to set up an account. When you have filled in your details and agreed to the terms and conditions, you'll be able to log in anywhere - including from home - with your username and password.



4. Choose the language you want to learn from the list available. (Note: this is a snapshot. There are lots more languages available!)



5. Once you have chosen your language, you can access the various parts of Transparent Language Online via the Learning Screen. Start by trying the Welcome lesson – a short introduction with only a few words and phrases, designed to introduce you to some of the most common activities and get you used to the process of learning with Transparent Language Online.



6. You can set your own daily learning goal. The Practice panel gives you different activities to practice your listening, reading, speaking, and writing skills.
